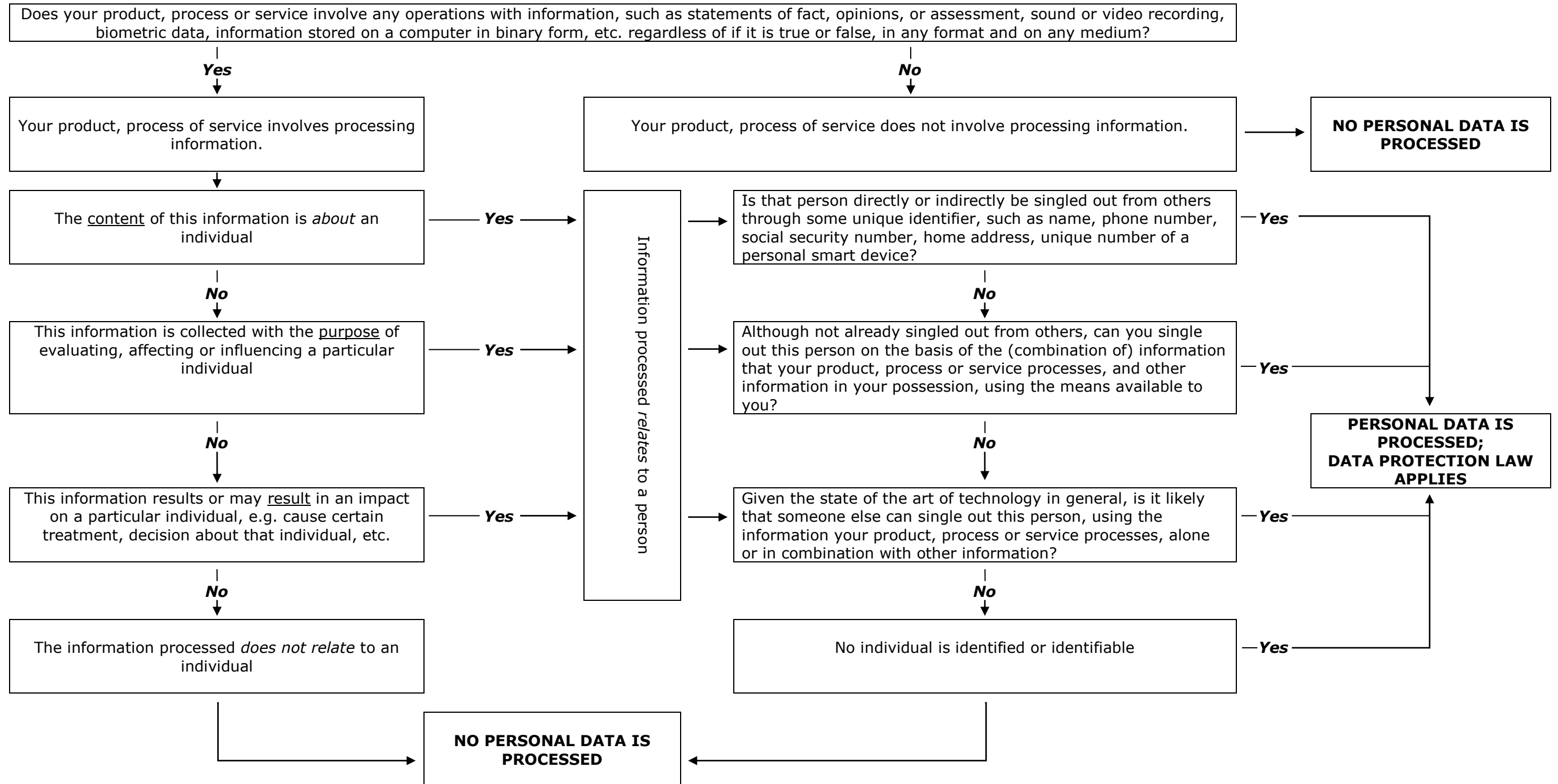




## DOES YOUR PRODUCT, PROCESS OR SERVICE PROCESS 'PERSONAL DATA' IN THE SENSE OF 1995 EU DATA PROTECTION DIRECTIVE? *Decision tree*



This decision tree was developed as a part of training materials for developers making use of FI-STAR eHealth PaaS. It is based on Opinion 4/2007 of Article 29 Working Party on the concept of personal data, adopted on 20 June 2007. The opinion is non-binding and national laws may use definitions of personal data that are different from the interpretation given by Article 29 Working Party. FI-STAR eHealth PaaS platform users to whom UK law applies may use this [UK ICO decision tree](#) that the UK supervisory authority suggests. Processing of personal data triggers application of data protection law (EU member states implement EU data protection directive in the national legislation). In addition, is personal data processed relates to health, it is subjected to special, stricter legal requirements.
